Maintaining a COVID safe environment in school

In line with DfE and Public Health guidance, I have reviewed our COVID risk assessment. We have taken some steps towards returning to 'normal' school life, with the options of returning to more COVID secure measures if we need to.

All children are now starting school at 8:50am and finishing school at 3.15pm. Regular handwashing and use of hand sanitiser is maintained. We have returned to all children eating lunch in the hall and have started some assemblies with smaller groups of children than usual. Whole school assemblies are being held on Zoom. We are closely monitoring all control measures.

The main symptoms of COVID are:

- A high temperature
- A new, continuous cough- this means coughing a lot more for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- A loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

Children should not attend school if they display any of the main COVID symptoms, but should book a free PCR test, which can be booked via this link Get a free PCR test to check if you have coronavirus (COVID-19) - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

It is very important that we are informed of any positive COVID tests in children as soon as possible. If you receive notification that your child has received a positive test during school hours e.g. 8am until 4pm, please call the school office on 0230 8340 2352. Outside of these times, please text or leave a voicemail to 07946 174469, stating the name and class of your child.

Term dates for 2021-22

As a voluntary controlled school, the St. Aidan's term dates are set by Haringey, who have made a change to this year's term dates.

To accommodate the additional public holiday for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee within the school calendar, Haringey have decided that the summer term 2022 will now finish on Thursday 21st July. The updated term dates for this academic year are shared in this edition of Headlines, as well as on the school website.

School meals

The cost of school lunches in Autumn 1 is £90. Please ensure payment is made via SchoolMoney if you pay for your child's school lunches.

If your child has packed lunch, please ensure they bring their lunch with them each morning.

Home learning and class routines

Home learning will be sent home to all classes in Y1 to 6 on Fridays, starting this week. This week's homework will include details of your child's class routines e.g. days that they need their PE kit etc. and an introduction from the class teacher.

Reducing lost property

Please help us to reduce the number of items ending up in our lost property by clearly labelling all your children's clothing.

PE kit

Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school for each PE lesson. We expect children to wear a white T shirt or polo shirt and blue or black shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Jewellery should be removed and long hair tied back. Suitable footwear must be worn for outdoor PE lessons; indoor PE is completed in bare feet.

After school clubs

After school clubs start the week commencing Monday 20th September. A letter with full details is included in this edition of Headlines and a paper copy is being sent home in book bags today. Applications for after school clubs <u>must be submitted by 10am on Monday 13th September</u>.

Breakfast club

Breakfast club is run by St. Aidan's staff. The club welcomes children from 7.30am and offers the opportunity to have a healthy breakfast and play with others, before joining their class to line up at 8.50am.

Breakfast club costs £4 a session and can be booked via SchoolMoney. The club runs really flexibly and can be used as and when needed by parents.

St. Aidan's YMCA after school club

The YMCA after school provision is a fun environment for St .Aidan's School children as well as some local schools (drop-in members). During each session there are a number of exciting activities for children of mixed abilities to enjoy. Activities range from Arts and Crafts, Active games, board games, Book reading and much more. School streets in Haringey

The Haringey Smarter Travel team has asked me to share the following information on School Streets, which may impact on your journeys in the local area.

School Streets are important schemes to help us combat the air pollution and road safety issues in Haringey.

There are 4 more starting this term, bringing the total to 16 in Haringey, there could be another 9 coming in with the low traffic neighbourhoods.

- Each school street has advanced warning signs and cameras plus promotional wraps at the junctions.
- There is a £130 fine when a vehicle without an exemption goes through the zone.
- Exemptions are specific for residents, some staff and parents/carers with blue badges needing to access the area (not just blue badge holders)
