School meals

The cost of school lunches in Autumn 1 is £87.50. Please ensure payment is made via SchoolMoney if you pay for your child's school lunches. If your child has packed lunch, please ensure they bring their lunch with them each morning.

Home learning and class routines

Home learning will be sent home to all classes in Y1 to 6 on Fridays, starting this week. This week's homework will include details of your child's class routines e.g. days that they need their PE kit etc. and an introduction from the class teacher.

Reducing lost property

<u>PE kit</u>

Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school for each PE lesson. We expect children to wear a white T shirt or polo shirt and blue or black shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Jewellery should be removed and long hair tied back. Suitable footwear must be worn for outdoor PE lessons; indoor PE is completed in bare feet.
